- ◆ After nominating a student, letters will be sent to you to forward to your students. At that time, they will formally have the opportunity to apply to be named a New England Young Scholar. **There is no charge** to receive this designation. Later, a book will be compiled with an "honor roll" featuring the names of all New England Young Scholars plus a short biography on each student.
- ◆ Participating schools receive a complimentary certificate, suitable for framing, congratulating them on being a participant in the New England Young Scholars program. Schools and participating teachers will be noted for their participation in both print and on the Internet.
